**IMPORTS AND EXPORTS CONTROL ACT, No. 1 OF 1969**

IN terms of the powers vested in me by Section 20 read together with Sub-section 4(1) and Section 14 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, No. 1 of 1969 as amended by Act, No. 48 of 1985 and Act, No. 28 of 1987, I, Ranil Wickremesinghe, the Minister of Finance, Economic Stabilization and National Policies, promulgate following Regulations.

**Regulations**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the “**Imports and Exports(Control) Regulations No. 18 of 2022**”.
2. The Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 10 of 2021, published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2231/18 dated June 11, 2021, as amended is hereby further amended.

- 2.1 Notwithstanding the Regulation No. 8 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Regulations No. 10 of 2021 referred above, importation of Broken Rice (**HS Code 1006.40.00**), listed out in the **Schedule I** of the said Regulations, by the Food Promotion Board or On-Account of the Food Promotion Board on prior recommendation of the Secretary, Ministry in charge of subject of Agriculture for the purpose of animal feed production shall be allowed by the Director General of Sri Lanka Customs. Total quantity of 25,000 metric tons shall only be allowed.
3. The Director General of Sri Lanka Customs shall consult the Secretary, Ministry in charge of subject of Agriculture on any importation made in violation of the Regulation No. 2.1 above.
4. The Controller General, Department of Imports and Exports Control shall issue required "Operating Instructions" to the Director General, Sri Lanka Customs and licensed banks for effective implementation of these Regulations.
